In December, a select number of Spark teams will be participating in WPI's The Wave signature event and then all teams will be headed to Pemibaker to compete on 12/14.

BIO TREK NEWS

This week our BioTrek team visited ARMI and UNH Manchester. What follows is a brief description of the experience in their words. "At ARMI today, we conducted a small lab and presented a hypothetical cure for Hashimoto's disease that we designed as part of a group project. This activity allowed us to apply scientific knowledge creatively while exploring potential approaches to treating autoimmune disorders. Later at UNH, we shifted our focus to cell culture and gained a deeper understanding of the processes involved in decellularization and recellularization. These discussions highlighted their importance in tissue engineering and regenerative medicine, offering practical insights into how these techniques are applied in real-world research and therapies. Overall, the day provided a well-rounded experience, combining hands-on work with opportunities to expand our theoretical knowledge." We are really excited for our students to have this accessible opportunity to learn about tissue engineering and organ manufacturing.
